"The Ignorance Of The Information Age"

Despite technological advancements, man remains the same as when the Lord God made him. You can dress a man in a three piece suit, give him a cell phone, teach him to build a space shuttle and "surf the net", yet without God, man is lost. Man continues to ask, "Who am I? What am I doing here? Where am I going?". But, apart from God, man has no satisfactory answers for living his life. The Old Testament declares that there is no new thing under the sun. In other words, the nature of man remains unchanged. Man's need for change resides within, not without. God's provision for man is clearly set forth in His Word. In 1844 the Supreme Court (contemporary with James Madison) ruled in favor of teaching the Bible in our schools. The following is from Vidal vs. Girard: "Why may not the Bible, and especially the New Testament ... be read and taught as a divine revelation in the [school] its general precepts expounded and its glorious principles of morality inculcated ... Where can the purest principles of morality be learned so clearly or so perfectly as from the New Testament?"

In 1962 a new Supreme Court ruled to separate Christian principles from education, school prayer was outlawed. This was done with <u>NO</u> legal precedents.
